ASLCS is proud to be partnering with Nakusp PharmaChoice in supporting the Return It Forward Program. You can drop off empty bottles and cans anytime at the Return It Forward trailer at the ASLCS building.

Trailer Location & Drop Off Times

The trailer is located at the ASLCS Office (205 6th Ave. NW in Nakusp, BC) and drop off is available 24/7 through a window on the side of the trailer.

Where do the funds go?

The program provides employment for individuals with diverse abilities and the funds help cover wages and costs of operating the Community Works Program.

What is accepted?

- ✓ Beverages Cans
- ✓ Glass & Plastic Bottles
- ✓ Tetras (juice boxes, cartons, gable top containers)
- ✓ Wine Bottles and boxes
- ✓ All dairy and dairy substitute beverage containers

What is NOT accepted?

- x Dairy containers that are NOT considered a beverage ie: creamo, whipping cream, etc.
- x Soup broth cartons
- x Soup tins

Considerations & Appreciations

Having an abundance of loose recycling in the trailer creates a potentially hazardous work environment for our team and increases labour times and decreases efficiency. Here are some considerations and appreciated measures that you can do to help:

- ❖ Bag bottles instead of boxing them, often bottles will move around in the trailer as it fills and items fall out of the boxes. Bagging keeps it together and allows any broken glass to be contained.
