The wood shop provides work experience and skill development for our clients while also offering employment to individuals with diverse abilities who experience significant barriers to finding and sustaining employment elsewhere.

Under the direction of supervisors, the shop provides a venue to teach a variety of skills to our participants of the Bridging the Labour Market Gap program – safety, awareness and planning, goal-setting and confidence building as well as actual wood working, refurbishing and finishing.
